**REQUIREMENTS**

**PHOTO IDENTIFICATION**

Parent/Guardian photo ID for summer camp children must be presented. A photographic copy will be made and retained in the office.

**BIRTH CERTIFICATE:**

An original birth CERTIFICATE must be presented at the time of registration. A photostatic copy is then made for our files and the parents retain the original. These certificates are used to authenticate information.

**IMMUNIZATION:**

A CERTIFICATE of immunization MUST be on file PRIOR to the first day of camp attendance. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS ARE MADE. We are fulfilling state law requirements.

**DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES:**

A notarized affidavit and child's medical report must be completed upon registration. These requirements allow us to maintain "Church Exempt" status in regards to State Licensing. Notarization is performed free of charge in the school office.

**PERSONAL LIABILITY RELEASE FORM:**

A form of personal liability release must be completed for each child's participation in summer camp activities. This release form protects the school/church and its officials from malicious lawsuits.

**SUPPLIES:**

All Children: Swim Suit, Swim cap for girls (if desired), and Towel  
Ages 3-6: Resting Mat and Change of Clothes  
All items should be marked with the child's name (permanent ink should be used).

**FOOD SERVICES:**

Currently we do not operate a full service cafeteria during the summer months. Children are required to bring lunches from home. Many summer activities call for specific instruction depending on the events for that day, however, as a general rule, children may bring microwaveable foods (in microwaveable dishes). Some basic food services are offered. These are:

Entering 2<sup>nd</sup> – Entering 6<sup>th</sup> \*\$85.00

### **DAILY RATE:**

Daily Drop-In (6:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.)

Ages 4-Entering 1st \*\$24.00

Entering 2<sup>nd</sup> – Entering 6<sup>th</sup> \*\$22.00

Payments for Drop-ins are due at the time of drop off.

**DISCOUNTS: There are no discounts available for Summer Camp.**

### **PAYMENTS:**

Weekly Rates and Fees are paid in advance of the week. Payments not received by Tuesday afternoon shall incur a \$10.00 late fee. This fee is automatically assessed to your account. Children will not be allowed to attend camp if the account is more than 5 days late. Children may attend once the account is brought up to date, providing the current week's fee has also been paid in advance.

**Daily Rates are due at the time of drop off.** All payments for drop-ins not paid on the day of drop-in will be charged a \$5.00 per day late fee.

### **LATE PICK—UP FEE:**

There is a \$10.00 PER QUARTER HOUR fee for any child not picked up by 6:00 p.m. The official school time clock is used as the correct time of day in deciding this matter. Late pick-up fees are automatically assessed to your account. Extreme emergencies may be presented to the administration for consideration.
